## SCHOOL EXHIBIT

**THEME:** Facts and Fantasy

This section is open to all primary schools in the Marburg district. Each school is to exhibit their schools' interpretation of "Facts and Fantasy" and must display the name of their school and theme in the exhibit.

Each exhibit must contain schoolwork including original handwriting, computer, art, craft and design work completed by the pupils of that school in 2022. Displays will be judged on Presentation, Theme, Message, Content, Detail and Standard of School Work, Arts, Craft and Design.

The Marburg & District Agricultural & Industrial Association Inc's Annual Show will be held under the Rules and regulation of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (Q.C.A.S.)

**All Exhibitors attending the Show are to pay Admission Fees.**

The Marburg & District Agricultural & Industrial Association Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to the person, property or stock of any owner, contestant, exhibitor, or assistant.

All Pavilion Exhibits must be in the hands of the Stewards as directed under the heading of each Section and must not be removed before 7.00 pm the last day of the Show, or on Sunday Morning between 10.00 am and 12 noon.

The exhibitor irrevocably consents to the Marburg and District Agricultural & Industrial Association Inc publishing or reproducing in any manner whatsoever any particulars or information in relation to their exhibits; the publication or reproduction may be in a printed form or visual image through electronic means and/or on the internet. Your personal information will not be disclosed without your consent for any other purpose unless required by law.

Each exhibitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Mar Marburg and District Agricultural & Industrial Association Inc. staff, stewards, and volunteers, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

All persons exhibiting must accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the committee, and on all protests the decision of the Committee shall be final without appeal, provided that the exhibitor shall have the right of appealing against disqualification imposed as provided for in the Constitution of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies. No protest will be considered unless it is presented to the Secretary, in writing with the PROTEST FEE of \$50.00, which may be forfeited should the committee consider the protest frivolous. Any person or persons interfering with a Judge, or who shall be guilty of unseemly conduct to a Judge or Steward or Official of the Association, or any exhibitors refusing in any way to carry out the instructions of a Steward, shall be liable, at the discretion of the Committee, to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00, or otherwise, may be disqualified from exhibiting for any period, or may be expelled from the grounds, together with his / her or their exhibits.

The Association reserves the right to alter the time or order of an event. The Association reserves the right to refuse any nomination by any exhibitor without reason. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or reduce the prize money through lack of competition.
