Prize Collection Information:

Prize money to be collected at the Show Office: Paintings may be sold at the Show.

The Marburg & Dist. A&I Assoc. Inc. will retain a 10% plus G.S.T. commission.

All exhibits must be the original work of the Exhibitor & completed in the **past 12 months**.

Entry requirements:

All paintings **MUST** be ready for hanging, preferably with wire or string no hooks.

Loose papers and soft cardboard are not acceptable.

All Paintings not to exceed 90cm X 90cm including frame.

Exhibitor's Name and Class being entered MUST be on back of ALL paintings.

The stewards reserve the right to refuse to hang any entry deemed unsuitable and to change the nominated class.

OPEN TO AMATEURS ONLY. Other Entry requirements above:

1. Landscape – Any medium.
2. Seascape or Water Scene – Any Medium
3. Pastels – any subject
4. Animals / Birds – any medium
5. Still life – any medium
6. Portrait / Figures –any medium
7. Mixed Media – Any subject
8. Drawing – Any Subject (sponsored prize \$7 1st , \$4 2nd from Marburg Art Group)
9. Any Subject – Any Medium
10. Senior – 70 years and over – Any Subject, Any Medium.

NOVICE: Exhibitors, who won first prize in a Novice Class are not eligible to enter that class again.

Any Novice class eligible for Australian theme Prize (Special Branch Collective) if noted on entry.

11. Landscape / water scene - any medium
12. Sunset – any medium
13. Still Life - any medium (sponsored prize \$7 1st , \$4 2nd from Marburg Art Group)
14. Animals and/or Birds - any medium

Sponsored prize vouchers will be decided and awarded during judging and will depend on the size of the art categories, unless nominated to a category.

SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Marburg & District A. & I. Association Inc.'s Annual Show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (Q.C.A.S.).

All Exhibitors attending the Show are to pay Admission Fees. The Marburg and District A. & I. Association Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to the person, property or stock of any owner, contestant, exhibitor or assistant. Each participant, by the act of his/her entry, waives all claim against the Association for injuries he/she or his/her property may sustain or that his/her animal may cause. All persons enter the Show Ring at their own risk. Small children and persons who, by their actions, present a risk to themselves or others will be directed, by the Stewards, to leave the Ring. Baby's prams/strollers are **not allowed** to enter the Show Ring.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT 1995 AND ELECTRICAL SAFETY ACT 2002- Any exhibitors or persons attending the Show must ensure they comply with the provisions of these Acts. Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor and have a current tag attached. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public. This is a requirement under the provisions of the Electrical Safety Act 2002 and Marburg District Agricultural and Industrial Association Inc. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Marburg Show Grounds. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showgrounds to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties. If necessary, a certified electrician will be on the grounds to carry out an inspection and tagging, however, there will be a charge for this service.

All Pavilion Exhibits must be in the hands of the Stewards as directed under the heading of each Section and **must not be removed before 9.00p.m.** the last day of the Show. All persons exhibiting must accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Committee, and on all protests the decision of the Committee shall be final without appeal, provided that the exhibitor shall have the right of appealing against disqualification imposed as provided for in the Constitution of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies. No protest will be considered unless it is presented to the Secretary, in writing with the PROTEST FEE \$50.00, which may be forfeited should the Committee consider the protest frivolous. Any person or persons interfering with a Judge, or who shall be guilty of unseemly conduct to a Judge or Steward or Official of the Association, or any exhibitors refusing in any way to carry out the instructions of a Steward, shall be liable, at the discretion of the Committee, to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00, or otherwise, may be disqualified from exhibiting for any period, or may be expelled from the grounds, together with his/her or their exhibits. The Association reserves the right to alter the time or order of an event. The Association reserves the right to refuse any nomination by any exhibitor without reason. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or reduce the prize money through lack of competition. Patrons must park vehicles as directed by Stewards. All ring events will be broadcast. All ring events will be run under the Rules, By-laws and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies. Any exhibit entered in the wrong class must be transferred to the right class at the discretion of the Judge. Stallions are **NOT** permitted to compete in Hack classes unless specified. A Judge shall not have any information prior to or during judging at an agricultural Show other than what is provided by the Marburg Show Association only.
