SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The Marburg & District A. & I. Association Inc.'s Annual Show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (Q.C.A.S.). **All Exhibitors attending the Show are to pay Admission Fees.** The Marburg and District A. & I. Association Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to the person, property or stock of any owner, contestant, exhibitor or assistant. Each participant, by the act of his/her entry, waives all claim against the Association for injuries he/she or his/her property may sustain.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY ACT 2002 - Any exhibitors or persons attending the Show must ensure they comply with the provisions of these Acts. Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor and have a current tag attached. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public. This is a requirement under the provisions of the Electrical Safety Act 2002 and Marburg District Agricultural and Industrial Association Inc. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Marburg Show Grounds. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showgrounds to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties. If necessary, a certified electrician will be on the grounds to carry out an inspection and tagging, however, there will be a charge for this service.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT 1995 - NO MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES THROUGH THE GROUNDS

BETWEEN 9.00A.M. AND 8.00P.M., excepting Ambulance or Emergency Vehicles. Patrons/exhibitors must park vehicles at the park in Main Street, Marburg or on Queen Street if they can find a park, as there is limited areas for parking away from where the public walk.

First Gate entrance into Marburg Show Grounds – Judges and into the Disabled Parking Area, Only.

Third Gate entrance into Marburg Show Grounds – is for horse entrants. They park up on the hill and at the back of the grounds, as they need to tie their horses to their floats.

PAVILIONS:

Pavilion Exhibits must be in the hands of the Stewards as directed under the heading of each Section. Exhibits **MUST NOT BE REMOVED** before 6.30p.m. on the Saturday of the Show. They can be collected on Sunday Morning between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00p.m.

All persons exhibiting must accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Committee, and on all protests the decision of the Committee shall be final without appeal, provided that the exhibitor shall have the right of appealing against disqualification imposed as provided for in the Constitution of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies. No protest will be considered unless it is presented to the Secretary, in writing with the PROTEST FEE \$50.00, which may be forfeited should the Committee consider the protest frivolous. Any person or persons interfering with a Judge, or who shall be guilty of unseemly conduct to a Judge or Steward or Official of the Association, or any exhibitors refusing in any way to carry out the instructions of a Steward, shall be liable, at the discretion of the Committee, to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00, or otherwise, may be disqualified from exhibiting for any period, or may be expelled from the grounds, together with his/her or their exhibits. The Association reserves the right to alter the time or order of an event. The Association reserves the right to refuse any nomination by any exhibitor without reason. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or reduce the prize money through lack of competition.

All prizes awarded at the Show must be collected on the day or as soon as possible in cases where there is a protest. All prizes not collected will be forfeited to the Association. Prize- winners of over \$50.00 - (Forms available at Show Sec.'s office) G.S.T. registered prize- winners claim G.S.T. on prize money by issuing a Tax Invoice including A.B.N. PLEASE NOTE:

All exhibitors attending the Marburg Show must pay admission fees.

Entries to be collected after 6.30 p.m. on Saturday 11th May in the Photography Pavilion. Uncollected Entries and Prizes will be at the Show Office between 10am and 12.00pm on Sunday 12th May 2024 or by arranging a suitable time by phoning 0409 481 681 – Sue).

Trophies not collected within 7 days will be forfeited to the Show Society.

People who work in the media or have a business relating to photography or published photographers are ineligible to enter.

All entries must be mounted on a single thickness of cardboard with a border around the photograph of no more than 20mm. Please do not use photo mounts, as they are difficult to display and may not be returned in the condition they were in when received.

- Name and Class to be on the back of all entries.
- All entries not to have been previously exhibited at the Marburg Show.
- All entries must be the competitor's own work.
- Limit of 5 entries per class per person.
- Photographs are not to be duplicated in other classes.
- No photographs of nudity or violence permitted.
- Any photos deemed inappropriate by the Stewards will not be displayed at the Show.
- If posting photos, please include a stamped self-addressed envelope for return of photos.
- **All prizes awarded at the Show must be collected on the day or as soon as possible in cases where there is a protest. All prizes not collected will be forfeited to the Association. Prize- winners of over \$50.00 - (Forms available at Show Sec.'s office)**
